WHAT DOES AMERICU CREDIT UNION AND AMERICU INSURANCE SERVICES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and account balances
- credit history and credit scores
- income and payment history

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons AmeriCU Credit Union and AmeriCU Insurance Services chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

To limit our sharing

Call toll-free (800) 388-2000, to limit sharing of your personal information and to not allow affiliates to market to you and/or nonaffiliates to market their products and services.

Please note:

If you are a *new* member, we can begin sharing your information 30 days from the date we sent this notice. When you are *no longer* our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

However, you can contact us at any time to limit our sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include financial companies, such as AmeriCU Credit Union and AmeriCU Services, LLC dba AmeriCU Insurance Services; and others, such as AmeriCU Foundation, Inc dba AmeriCU Charitable Foundation.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • AmeriCU Credit Union and AmeriCU Insurance Services does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.
